What does it mean if my system is affected?

1. We been updating the information systems that deal with employee data
2. These systems and others that depend on them will have to go offline during the transition to UCPath

When is all of this going to happen?

We are 100% dependent on campus UCPath transition dates and times

We must transition when they do

Transition will Happen in Two Phases:

September 16 – 17

Conversion of Employee Numbers

September 19

Conversion of Employment Data

We will have to take systems down on these dates

How will the transition take place?

September 16-17: Employee number Conversion

❖ Sunday, Sept. 16

- ❖ Notify campus of transition start
- ❖ Close systems and redirect websites to a friendly landing page

❖ Sunday – Monday (Sept. 16 – 17)

- ❖ Deploy system changes
- ❖ Update employee numbers **
- ❖ Test systems **

❖ Monday, Sept. 17

- ❖ Upon successful completion of system changes...
 - ❖ Restore normal services
 - ❖ Notify campus of transition completion

** We must wait for UCLA to finish before UCSB main campus can begin.

UCSB Campus Identity Systems must convert there systems before we can complete and test our changes

How will the transition take place?

September 19: Employment Information Conversion

- ❖ Wednesday, Sept. 19 (Approximately 6:30 p.m.)
 - ❖ Await notification of campus readiness
 - ❖ Notify campus of transition start
 - ❖ Close affected systems and redirect websites to friendly landing page
 - ❖ Deploy system changes
 - ❖ Update job data
 - ❖ Test systems
 - ❖ Upon successful completion of system changes... **
 - ❖ Restore normal services
 - ❖ Notify campus of transition completion

** We anticipate about a four hour conversion for this phase

What if something goes wrong during the transition?

- ❖ On the campus / UCPath end?
 - ❖ We're prepared to restore services to their prior operating state
- ❖ On the SIS&T end?
 - ❖ We have done extensive analysis and planning
 - ❖ We are doing a full dry run of the process in our test environment on September 7th
 - ❖ If something happens day of, we will fix and move forward. **If campus goes live, we must also**

How are we communicating this with the campus community?
